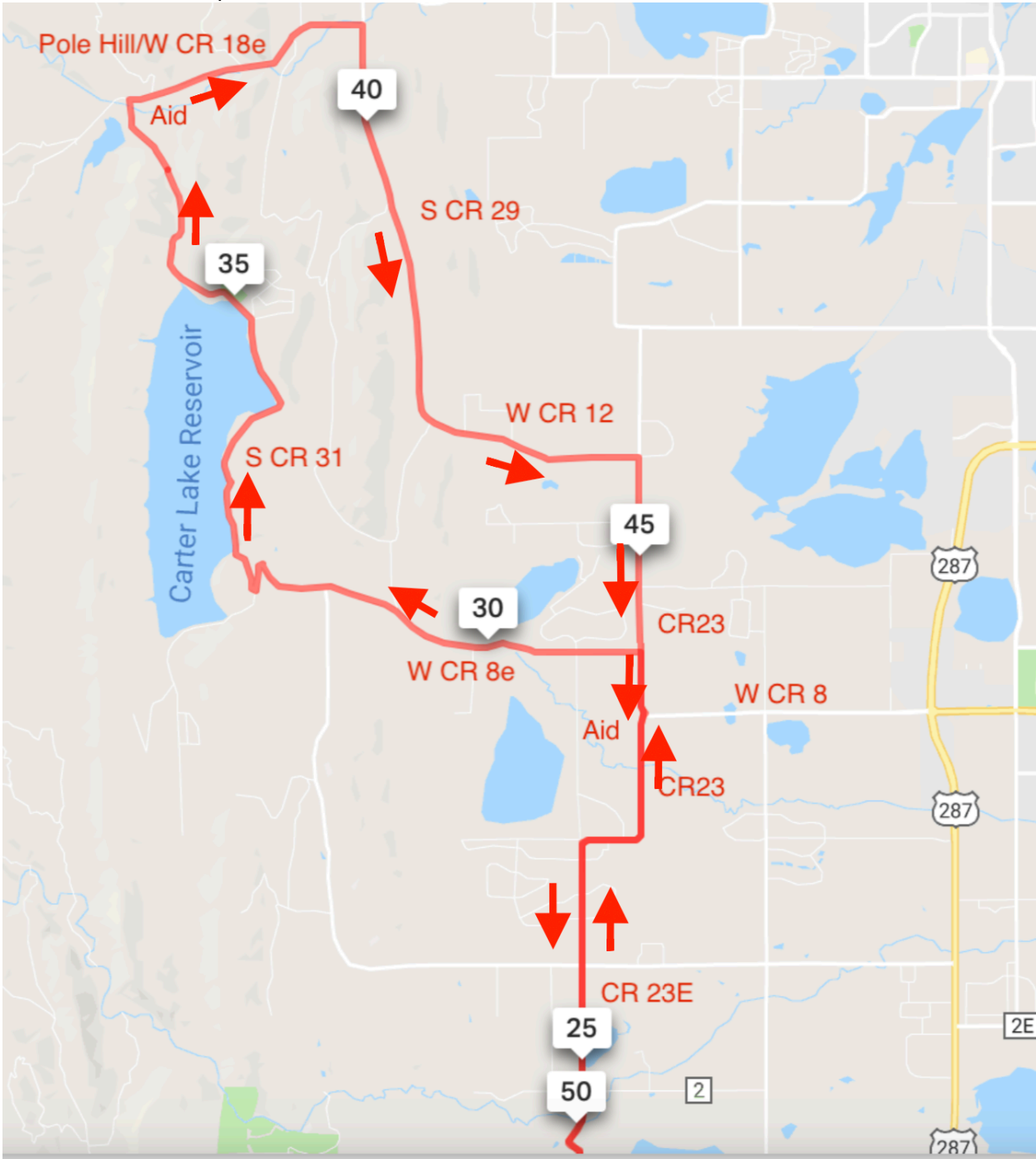


Buffalo Bicycle Classic Sept. 13, 2020. The 50, 70 and 100 mile routes in Larimer County. Numbers on the map indicate mile distances from start in Boulder for both routes.



The 50, 70 and 100 miles routes of the Buffalo Bicycle Classic enter Larimer County where N. 83<sup>rd</sup> St becomes CR 23E at N. County Line Rd just north of the Little Thomson River Bridge. The route proceeds north along CR 23E, continuing east on W CR 6 and north on CR 23 to the aid station at the intersection of N CR 23 and W CR 8. The 50 mile route turns around at the aid station. The 50 and 70 mile routes proceed around Carter Lake.

Left to stay on N CR 23

Left onto W CR 8e

Right on S CR 31 to proceed along the east and north side of Carter Lake, and proceed downhill

Right on Pole Hill Rd/W CR 18e. There is an aid station on Pole Hill Rd/W CR 18e 100 yards east of the intersection with S CR 31

Right onto S CR 29 which becomes W CR 12

Right at N CR 23 to the aid station at the intersection with W CR 8.

Right to stay on N CR 23, which becomes W CR 6 and CR 23E. The route leaves Larimer County at N County Line Rd where N CR 23 becomes N. 83<sup>rd</sup> St.
