

STARTING LINE (6:30 am – 8:30 am)



Entering the Starting Line:

- Riders will be allowed to line-up starting 15 minutes prior to the starting time once the road is closed
- All cars will be held during the 20 minutes of the Start preparation and start. Road can reopen immediately after riders are all off 2nd avenue

Staggering the Start:

- Our event emcee will send riders off in groups of 10, spaced 30 seconds apart
- Once the group in front of them has set off on course, all groups will move up to the next available set of squares

100 mile riders: 6:15 am line up, 6:30 am start (Road Closure 6:15am – 6:35am)

60 mile riders: 7:15 am line up, 7:30am start (Road Closure 7:15am – 7:35am)

30 mile riders: 8:15 am line up, 8:30 am start (Road Closure 8:15am – 8:35am)

No participant cars will be allowed in the park during road closure times and participants will be told prior to ride

Riders Needing Packet Pick-Up or Gear Check:

- Riders who need to check their gear or who have elected to pick up their packets on event day will need to park their bikes in bike parking and follow the arrows to the gear check and packet pick up tents
- They will then follow festival exit signage to exit the area, return to their bikes and proceed to the starting line

FINISH LINE & FESTIVAL (10:00 am – 5:00 pm)

100 mile route will travel in from Railroad Ave

















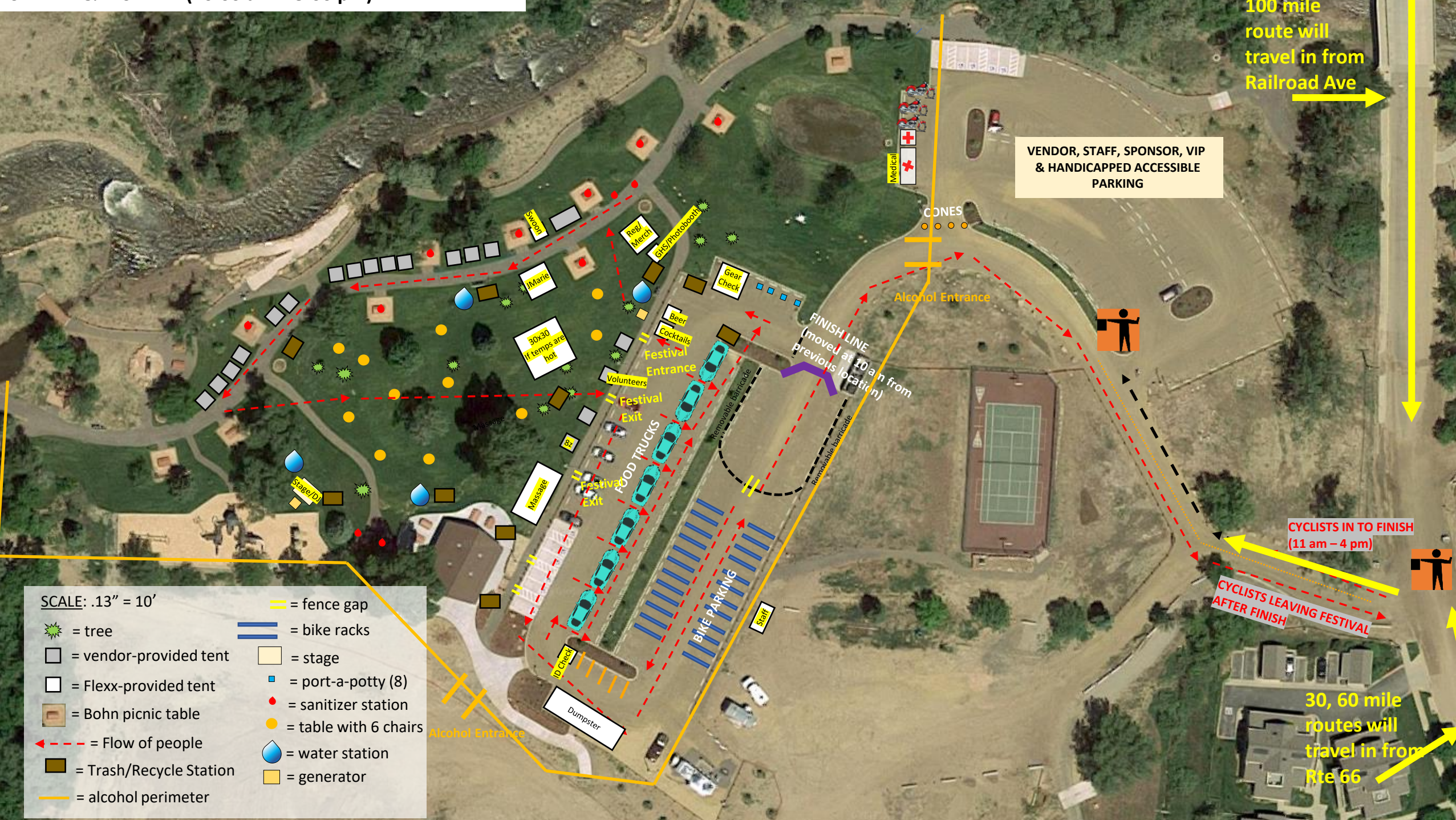
CYCLISTS IN TO FINISH (11 am – 4 pm)

Parking Plan:

Participants/Volunteers

- 100 Mile, 60 Mile Riders & Volunteers will park at the Lyons Waste Water Treatment Center on a first come, first serve basis
- When that is filled they will park at the Church of the Latter Day Saints
