Hi Todd and Bill,

Here are the two documents that I found regarding the Trustees agreeing to come into the boundary.

As part of the review, we asked for a determination on the liquor permit. 36 CFR § 5.2 (alcoholic beverages; sale of intoxicants) does not apply to the area of the ranch where you are proposing to sell alcohol. So the Trust and the Ride the Rockies applicants only need to apply for a county permit. There is a small area of ranch lands inside the boundary that are in our legislative jurisdiction, where the CFR would apply. I will make sure that Larimer County is aware that no liquor sales permit is required from us for the current event applications.
